

Bulky Item Pick-up Process for North Richmond Mitigation Area Residents

- Submit completed Prescreening Form, photo ID and recent utility or phone bill to prove residency in the North Richmond Mitigation Area to the Prevent Service Coordinator (PSC) for processing.
- If PSC determines household is within North Richmond Mitigation Area and you submit all required information, PSC will call the phone number provided to confirm eligibility for a Bulk Item Pick-up
- Contact the PSC at 510-260-0005 x15 for questions regarding this program. Depending upon the nature of your question/concern, CSC may refer your call to RSS or staff from the City of Richmond/Contra Costa County.

Eligibility

- Program is available for a limited time, services provided on a first come first served basis.
- Only households located within the North Richmond Mitigation Area (map can be viewed online at www.cccrecycle.org/NRGreen) that are residential customers of RSS are eligible to have bulky items picked up at their residence for free.
- Eligible households may request one bulky item pick-up per year, but only if household has not already claimed one or more disposal vouchers in same year.
- You must provide photo identification and recent phone or utility bill to prove residency at address within North Richmond Mitigation Area in order for request to be processed.

Pick-up Guidelines

- Items are not authorized for pick-up until you have contacted RSS and received confirmation of a scheduled pick up date.
- RSS will only pick-up those items that resident checks on the Application and have been pre-authorized. Any unauthorized/ineligible items placed on the curb will not be picked up.
- Bulky items authorized for pick up must be placed on the curb no later than 6:00am on the scheduled collection day. If bulky items authorized for pick-up on the scheduled pick-up day are not placed out for collection, household will not be eligible for another pick-up until following year.
- See the reverse side for additional recycling and disposal resources for various bulky items and other items not allowed in curbside garbage collection program.

Eligible Bulky Items – up to 3 per pick-up:

By checking items and signing the Application, you will be authorizing RSS to charge your account and agree to pay the amount exceeding \$60 (ranges from \$15-\$60 depending on cost of the items selected).

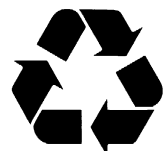
